Section 3 – Disqualification by association

Section 4 – Provision of Information

If you have answered YES to any of the questions above you should provide details below in respect of yourself, or where relevant the member of your household. You may supply this information separately if you wish, but you must do so without delay. The information should include:

- (a) Details of the order, determination, conviction or other ground for disqualification from registration under the Childcare (Disqualification) Regulations 2009;
- (b) The date of the order, determination or conviction or the date when the other ground for disqualification arose;
- (c) The relevant body or court which made the order, determination or conviction and the sentence (if any) imposed;
- (d) A certified copy of the relevant order, caution, conviction, reprimand or warning.

Section 5 – Declaration

In signing this form, I confirm that the information provided above is true to the best of my knowledge and that:

- I understand my responsibilities to safeguard children.
- I understand that I must notify my Principal (or Vice Principal as appropriate) immediately of anything that affects my suitability including any pending court appearances, cautions, reprimands, warnings, convictions, orders or other determinations made in respect of me or a member of my household that may render me to be disqualified under the terms of the Childcare (Disqualification) Regulations 2009 from working with children.
